  - 3 spec Pre K will be at Mead.
  - Cannoli truck first week of May.
  - Governor said we do not need to offer a remote option for next year. If that is the case, students will need to withdraw and become homeschool or the other proposal at the State legislature is for them to work with ex: ACES. It is difficult to do both.
  - Another bill is the "indoor quality bill"... To look at filtration. Ducts cleaned, filters changed consistently, and open and closing schools based on temperature. (Ex: if temp in room drops below 50 degrees, must close school). Working with OSHA
  - Mat involved with 3 bills surrounding funding for the betterment of education in CT/Ansonia.
  - People need to know we don't just have meetings and complain
  - No pink slips this year.
  - School system getting a lot of money for Covid relief. In a much better place funding wise.
  - Over the next 2 months we would like celebrate landmark years of service; and other positive things going on with teachers (grants, etc)
